

DANIELLE E. WARREN is Associate Professor of Management and Global Business at Rutgers Business School – Newark & New Brunswick, Rutgers University.

Professor Warren's research builds upon normative and descriptive theory and includes qualitative and quantitative examinations of moral emotions, constructive and destructive deviance, collective corruption and workplace attributes that lead to ethical organizational cultures, such as sanctioning systems, ethics training and ethical leadership. Her field work includes in-depth studies of auto insurance fraud investigations, sanctioning systems on financial exchanges and ethics training in banking. Her work has been published in *Academy of Management Review*, *Accounting and the Public Interest*, *Business and Professional Ethics Journal*, *Business and Society*, *Business Ethics Quarterly*, *Business & Society Review*, *Group Decision & Negotiation*, *Journal of Business Ethics*, *Organization Science*, and *Research in Organizational Behavior*. Professor Warren teaches undergraduate, MBA and doctoral courses in business ethics. She is Senior Fellow of the Zicklin Center for Business Ethics Research at The Wharton School and Research Fellow of Rutgers' Institute for Ethical Leadership. She also serves on the Board of Directors for the Society for Business Ethics and the editorial board of *Business Ethics Quarterly*. She received an M.A. and Ph.D. from The Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania and a B.S. from Rutgers University, New Brunswick, NJ.
