I am Full Professor of Criminal Law at the University of Castilla la Mancha (Spain) and Deputy Director of its Institute of European and International Criminal Law. I collaborate with several international criminal law associations. I am Vice President of the Spanish Section of the International Criminal Law Association and a member of its International Scientific Committee.

My most important fields of research actually is corporate criminal law. In recent years I have dealt with the criminal liability of legal persons and compliance programmes. In addition to numerous publications on this subject, I have also advised major Spanish companies and business associations.

I was also a pioneer in the development of European Union Criminal Law. This speciality has led me to have an important international projection, and to participate in numerous research projects with other colleagues from European Universities. At this point, I would like to highlight my membership of the European Policy Criminal Initiative, a research group whose opinions are taken into consideration by the European institutions.

I have been a scholar of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, visiting professor at the University of Modena Reggio Emilia (Italy) and I have carried out research stays in Cambridge and several German universities (Freiburg iBr and Tübingen). I have also worked as a consultant for the United Nations and the German Agency for International Cooperation.
